ALPHA School-Based Program

The Alpha Program is an alternative educational and counseling Program designed to serve 4th through 8th grade students having difficulties in the regular classroom setting. Alpha assesses and addresses risk factors in the children's environment, which may contribute to their problems.

The teachers and guidance counselors in the elementary schools make referrals to Alpha, based on knowledge of a child's academic performance and behavior.

Students usually remain in the program for one school year. Alpha staff works with each child to develop individualized participation plans, which establish both academic and behavioral goals. Individual and group counseling, along with academic instruction are provided to meet these goals.

Many students experience academic difficulties prior to entering the program. Alpha counselors will work closely with the classroom teacher to meet specific learning styles of the student. Each student is pre and post tested to measure progress.

The Alpha counselors are available to the students, parents and teachers throughout the year.
